

Why Plan?

- Helps communities prepare for the future.
- Identifies problems and points the way to solutions by taking a measured, systematic approach.
- Provides a rationale for assigning priorities and decision-making.
- Provides the opportunity for educating, involving, and informing the community and elected officials.



What is a Comprehensive Plan?

A Comprehensive Plan is a long range, general policy guide that provides a written and graphic description of existing conditions, community aspirations, and a "road map" to ensure the community vision is achieved through sound decision-making regarding future growth and development, and capital improvements.

- How do we maintain what Artesians cherish about the community?
- What is the vision for Artesia in 20 years – how should it grow and develop?



How would you describe Artesia to someone who has never been to Artesia and was thinking about moving here?




What are the top three aspects about Artesia that should be preserved for the future?
