



Q2 How long have you lived in Artesia?






Q4 How likely are you to live in Artesia for the next 2 to 5 years?





Q7 How would you rate the quality of life in Artesia?



Q8 What is your favorite aspect about Artesia? (choose all that apply).







Q10 Please indicate the recreational or entertainment facilities that you or members of your family currently use (choose all that apply).







Q13 Artesia Municipal Court provides adequate services.



Q14 Are you currently employed?







Q17 If you feel like you need more job training, what type of training or education would that be?





Q21 What types of economic development are needed in Artesia? (choose all that apply).









Q24 Artesia should encourage development that allows people to live and work in the same building or on the same site.



Q25 Downtown Artesia is a fun place to visit, shop, and walk around.



Q26 Downtown Artesia needs more of the following (choose all that apply).







Q28 Artesia has adequate multi-modal (vehicle, transit, bicycle, trails, sidewalks) transportation system.



Q29 The City should focus on the following transportation and infrastructure improvements (choose all that apply).







Q33 Artesia needs more of the following types of housing (choose all that apply).







Q37 What is the highest level of education you have attained?


